
We would like to wish the very best to team members that are leaving




Cases of whooping





We know that people may be concerned about their own health following recent media coverage, so the NHS have set up a new online resource for patients and the public to find help and support - https://nhs.uk/infected-blood-support

This is a new online resource and is available for patients and the public to find support services from across the NHS and the Government and NHS staff can access their local employers' support services.




